BENEDICTION OF THE BLESSED SACRAMENT

HYMN 204 (kneeling)

V Thou art the King of Glory, O Christ.

R Thou art the everlasting Son of the Father.

V When thou tookest upon thee to deliver man, thou
didst humble thyself to be born of a Virgin.

R When thou hadst overcome the sharpness of death,
thou didst open the Kingdom of Heaven to all believers.

V Thou sittest at the right hand of God, in the glory of
the Father.

R We believe that thou shalt come to be our Judge.

V We therefore pray thee, help thy servants, whom thou
hast redeemed with thy precious Blood.

R Make us to be numbered with thy saints, in glory ever-
lasting.

HYMN 200 (3rd tune) (kneeling)

V Thou gavest us bread from Heaven:

R Containing in itself all sweetness.

V Let us pray: O Lord, Jesus Christ, who in a wonderful
Sacrament hast left us the memorial of thy Passion:
Grant us, we beseech thee, so to reverence the sacred
mysteries of thy Body and Blood, that we may always
perceive within ourselves the fruit of thy redeeming
work; who livest and reignest with the Father, in the
unity of the Holy Spirit ever, one God, world without
end. AMEN.

(The Priest now goes to the Altar, takes the Sacred Host
in his hands, and, in silence, makes the sign of the
Cross over the kneeling congregation. After he has re-
placed the Host in the Ciborium, all rise:)

V Let us for ever adore the most Holy Sacrament.

R O praise the Lord, all ye nations, praise him all ye
peoples.

V For his merciful kindness is ever more and more to-
ward us, and the truth of the Lord endureth for ever.
Praise the Lord.

R Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the
Holy Ghost.

V As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be,
world without end. AMEN.

R Let us for ever adore the most Holy Sacrament.
